

## **Working with Children Clearance Requirements**

## by State/Territory

- Each state and territory has unique requirements for adults (and some children) working or volunteering with children.
- Multiple clearances may be necessary depending on jurisdiction.
- Obtain your clearance early to avoid delays.
- Note: If you're under 18, you may still need clearance. Contact your state/territory's relevant department or your school for guidance.
